TIPS FOR PURCHASING YOUR ANNUAL PASS

1. To receive senior rate: ensure your DOB is correct.
2. To receive resident rate: ensure your home address is correct and not listed as a PO Box.

OPEN PLAY COURTS – TENNIS (Unless reserved)

1. Tennis courts 1 & 2 are coaching and instruction courts.
2. Tennis courts 3-8 are open play courts 7 days a week.
3. Tennis courts are reserved occasionally for team practices/matches and weekend tournaments.

OPEN PLAY COURTS – PICKLEBALL (Unless reserved)

1. Pickleball courts 1-12 are open play courts 7 days a week.
2. Pickleball courts 9-12 may be reserved (fees apply) 7 days a week from 12pm - 5pm.

PLAYERS INTERESTED IN RESERVING A COURT MAY DO SO ONLINE USING THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES

1. Tennis courts 3, 4 & 5 are available to reserve 7 days a week from 12pm-5pm. Court rental fee is \$20-\$23/hr.
2. Pickleball courts 10 & 12 are available to reserve 7 days a week from 12pm-5pm. Court rental fee is \$20-\$23/hr.
3. Approved tennis instructors may reserve tennis courts 1, 2 and stadium for private lessons.
4. Approved pickleball instructors may reserve pickleball courts 9 & 11 for private lessons.
5. If not reserved, pickleball courts 9-12 and Tennis courts 3-5 are open play courts.
6. City sponsored classes, clinics, camps, tournaments, leagues, and court reservations have priority.
7. Instructors providing private instruction and charging a player fee are required to rent a court in advance.
 - 4 players maximum.
 - Players must show annual pass or pay 5\$ cash to gate monitor.
8. No refund provided if you reserve a court and do not use.

HOW TO RESERVE A MUNICIPAL PICKLEBALL OR TENNIS COURT

1. Courts must be reserved a minimum of 2 days in advance. No last-minute reservations accepted.
2. Courts may be reserved a maximum of 14 days in advance.

4. Players that reserve a court must present a copy of their permit when checking-in with monitor.
5. Players interested in reserving multiple courts are required to submit a request using the Court Rental Form located @ www.TeamSideline.Com/SantaBarbara

ADDITIONAL CITY TENNIS COURT INFORMATION

1. Municipal Tennis & Pickleball Courts

- 1414 Park Place
- Hours Monday-Sunday 8:30am-sunset
- 8 tennis courts and 12 pickleball courts
- Proof of Annual Pass or \$5 daily fee required upon entrance.
- Free hitting wall available.
- Free parking

2. Oak Park Tennis Courts

- 300 West Alamar Street
- Open Monday-Sunday sunrise to sunset (no lights)
- 2 tennis courts and 2 blended pickleball court lines – bring your own portable net system.
- Free recreational drop-in play
- Free parking

3. Pershing Park Tennis Courts

- 100 Castillo Street
- Monday-Friday 5:00pm-10:00pm
- Saturday-Sunday 8:00am-10:00pm
- 8 tennis courts & 4 blended lines pickleball courts
- Free recreational drop-in play
- Free parking
