Site-Specific Work Plan, Douglas Family Preserve

Santa Barbara City Fire Department and Parks and Recreation Department

Wildfire Resiliency Project



Existing Conditions

Douglas Family Preserve is regionally located within the City of Santa Barbara on the southern coast of California. Douglas Family Preserve totals approximately 70 acres and is located in the coastal zone of the High Fire Hazard Area, bordered by Elings Park to the north and the Pacific Ocean to the south (Figure 1). Land uses of the surrounding area is mostly residential development. Douglas Family Preserve is located within the United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute Santa Barbara topographic quadrangle in Section 00 of Township 4 North and Ranged 27 and 28 West, and Assessor Parcel Numbers (APNs) 047-140-001, 047-140-002, 047-140-003, and 047-140-004 (SummitWest 2024).

Douglas Family Preserve is centered at approximately 34.402582 latitude and -119.738889 longitude, and elevation of the park ranges from zero to 170 feet above mean sea level (msl). Over half of Douglas Family Preserve soil is made up of Baywood loamy sand 2-9% slopes, which is somewhat excessively drained, and derived from Beach sand (which also makes up about 13% of the Survey Area). Some of the preserve also contains Lopez-Rock outcrop complex 50-75% slopes, which is somewhat excessively drained and derived from Residuum weathered from siliceous shale (USDA 2023). This preserve is composed of nine different vegetation communities and two other land types. The native coast live oak woodland community makes up a majority of the park space, followed by the non-native eucalyptus woodland community. Douglas Family Preserve is an open space preserve with off-leash dog use allowance and a trail system running throughout.

Approach

Vegetation management work was performed by a City Fire Department seasonal crew from October – December 2024. In accordance with the CWPP, associated Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR), and Douglas Family Preserve Biological Resource Assessment (BRA), a biological evaluation/pre-activity survey was conducted on site within 10 days of scheduled work. Limits of work and environmentally sensitive areas were delineated on site prior to work commencement; following site mark-out, photo points were established for before and after photos to be included in the After-Action Report. An Environmental Awareness Training for all crew members will be held by a qualified biologist prior to commencement of vegetation management activities. A biological monitor will be present for project activities around sensitive natural resources, as needed, in accordance with the Douglas Family Preserve BRA recommended avoidance and mitigation measures.

Crews targetted deadwood and invasive species to reduce fuel loads in the preserve through weed whipping, hand cutting, hand pulling, chainsaw work, chipping, flattening, mowing, raking, shoveling, and bucking existing woody debris; details on each target work area are described in the photo document included below. Targeted invasive species include acacia, castor bean, young eucalyptus, olive, lollypop tree, sections of dried radish/crown daisy, Taiwan firethorn, iceplant, and ash.

Crews also focused on removing vegetation from official trails and fire access roads to maintain clear site access for emergency crews and vehicles in the event of a fire.

All tools shall be sanitized before use at the work site. If indication of plant disease, fungus, or pest is observed in any work area, tools were re-sanitized before proceeding on to next work area. All invasives were removed by root, or stump ground, when feasible. If not feasible, the City may seek an exemption from the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Advisory Committee to treat stumps with herbicide to inhibit regrowth; however, it is anticipated that mechanized removal will meet site goals in Douglas Family Preserve. Invasives in seed, or at risk of spreading due to rhizomes / vegetative debris will be disposed of off-site. Deadwood and mulch generated from site work was utilized on site to the greatest extent feasible.

This Site-Specific Work Plan functions as a working document. Work areas will be marked out and surveyed ahead of crew progression. This allows for all work to stay within the confines of a biological evaluation/pre-activity survey, and for adjustments to on-site conditions to be made, if needed.

Safety Plan

Designated work zones will be discussed with crew by crew lead and marked out as-needed on site. All crew members will always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE). Crew members using mechanized tools will be properly trained. Work will not occur during rain or other unsafe weather conditions.

Work Activity Schedule

Work schedule will between Monday and Thursday, between the hours of 8a.m. to 4:30 p.m., from October 2024 – January 2025. No weekend work is allowed unless an emergency necessitates it. Work is dependent on weather conditions.

Pre-Activity Biological Surveys

Pre-activity biological surveys were conducted in Work Areas 1-41 within 10 days of scheduled crew work. The pre-activity surveys were conducted by qualified biologists from Environmental Science Associates (ESA) and Pax Environmental (Pax) on October 7th and 21st, November 4th, and 18th, and December 2nd and 20th. During the pre-activity surveys, Work Areas were assessed for presence of sensitive biological resources, and were flagged to guide crew work. The purpose of the survey was to confirm the location and presence of sensitive biological resources that were documented and mapped in the preserve's BRA, and to clearly flag vegetation to be removed and vegetation to be preserved during project activities. All pre-activity surveys were conducted in accordance with the requirements in the City's Community Wildlife Protection Plan Final Program Environmental Impact Report (FPEIR) Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP), and Douglas Family Preserve BRA, to protect sensitive biological resources.

All pre-activity biological surveys were not protocol-level for special status species with potential to occur; additionally, the surveys were conducted in fall and winter, outside of the identifiable/blooming period for some plant species. Negative results do not guarantee species absence from the survey area. The survey dates, biologists, and activities are summarized in the table below. Raw survey reports are included as Attachment 1.

Conclusions

No significant environmental impacts were observed as a result of the project. No special-status plant or wildlife species were observed during any pre-activity surveys or work area checks. Prior to project implementation, ESA biologists conducted a Worker Environmental Awareness Program training to all crew members, which provided information on identifying protected species and habitats, avoiding impacts to rare and common native species, worker safety and reporting standards, contact information for key project staff, and an overview of the regulatory framework and codes governing the implementation and protection measures of the project. During project implementation, no proposed work area boundaries required adjustment to avoid impacts to protected resources. After project activities were completed for each work area, ESA and/or Pax biologists returned to document the conditions at each site. An After Action Report ("before" and "after" photo documentation) will be submitted following completion of all Project related work activities.



Work Area Descriptions

Work Areas will be finalized ahead of crews progression, following pre-activity survey / site mark out.







Habitat: Work area 5 consisted mostly of an oak and eucalyptus canopy with non-native annual herbs dominating the understory.

Work Description: Remove dry eucalyptus litter, crown daisy, and wild radish. Lift low eucalyptus branches to the extent feasible. Remove and stump grind young eucalyptus. Pull out all nasturtium by root and dispose of off site (trash bags / tarps).



Work Area #: 6

Habitat: Work area 6 was dominated by non-native annual herbs and grasses, with scattered native sagebrush.

Work Description: Remove dry wild radish, crown daisy, and foxtail grass around native sagebrush vegetation to the extent feasible. Remove giant yucca and stump grind.





Habitat: Work area 7 had an oak and eucalyptus canopy, with small patches of non-native annuals and


Work Description: Remove dry eucalyptus litter and lift low eucalyptus branches to the extent feasible. Remove and stump grind myoporum.



Work Area #: 8


Habitat: Work area 8 was dominated by a eucalyptus and acacia canopy, with few scattered native shrubs. Work Description: Remove dry eucalyptus litter and lift low eucalyptus branches to the extent feasible. Remove all young eucalyptus and acacia and stump grind removal sites. (Second round of acacia removal at this work area.)







Habitat: Work area 11 had an oak canopy with mix of native and non-native scrub understory.
Work Description: Remove acacia, Eugenia, palm, Taiwan firethorn; stump grind removal sites. Clean up oak deadwood. Lift cypress branches to make road accessible and remove dry fire ladder.















Habitat: Work area 15 had a eucalyptus canopy with native shrub and non-native grass understory.Work Description: Remove dry eucalyptus litter and lift low eucalyptus branches to the extent feasible.Remove young eucalyptus and stump grind removal site.



Work Area #: 16

Habitat: Work area 16 had young eucalyptus tree and an oak, surrounded by open, non-native herbaceous annual vegetation.

Work Description: Remove young eucalyptus and stump grind removal sites.





Habitat: Work area 19 consisted of native trees and shrubs with a non-native grass understory.
Work Description: Clean up 2 locations of large deadwood in work area. Leave large deadwood in place ("skeleton" of tree).





Work Area #: 20

Habitat: Work area 20 was dominated by non-native grasses and annual herbaceous species, predominately wild radish and crown daisy.

Work Description: Hedge dried wild radish and crown daisy.



Habitat: Work area 21 had a Eugenia surrounded by oaks and native shrubs.

Work Description: Remove Eugenia and stump grind removal site. Mulch from Eugenia to be broadcasted on to the removal site - do not put Eugenia seeds in new areas.



Work Area #: 22 Habitat: Work area 22 had an acacia tree surrounded by oak groves. Work Description: Remove dry acacia.









Habitat: Work area 25 was dominated by oaks and native trees.

Work Description: Remove two young ash trees and stump grind removal sites.



Work Area #: 26

Habitat: Work area 26 was dominated by non-native ice plant surrounded by native shrubs.

Work Description: Pull out and remove all iceplant by root; stage in place on tarp to dry out and be disposed of off site at a later date. Do not place tarp within dripline of any oaks.







Habitat: Work area 27 was dominated by oaks and native shrubs, with a couple non-native acacia trees. Work area was expanded westward to include the removal of an additional non-native acacia observed during the pre-activity survey.

Work Description: Remove acacias and Eugenia and stump grind removal sites.



Work Area #: 28 Habitat: Work area 28 was dominated by native shrubs and had non-native acacia trees. Work Description: Remove acacia and stump grind removal sites.







Habitat: Work area 29 has an open understory dominated by iceplant and surrounded by native trees.

Work Description: Pull out and remove all iceplant and English ivy by root; stage in place on tarp to dry out and be disposed of off site at a later date. Do not place tarp within dripline of any oaks.



Work Area #: 30 Habitat: Work area 30 had an oak canopy but was dominated by native shrubs and had one non-native pittosporum.

Work Description: Remove pittosporum and stump grind removal sites.





Habitat: Work area 31 had an oak canopy with nonnative ivy dominating the ground cover. **Work Description**: Pull out and remove all English ivy by root; stage on tarp to dry out and be disposed of off site at a later date. Do not place tarp within dripline of any oaks (maybe place tarp in mowed Work Area 4).





Work Area #: 32 Habitat: Work area 32 consisted of oaks and nonnative grasses, with an olive tree, with a large eucalyptus on the edge of the work area. Work Description: Remove olive and stump grind removal site.







Habitat: Work area 33 is dominated by California sagebrush with wild radish, crown daisy, and castor bean intermixed.

Work Description: Remove pittosporum and stump grind removal sites. Remove all castor bean; cut off seed heads and bag for disposal off site. Hedge adjacent dry wild radish and crown daisy.





Work Area #: 34

Habitat: Work area 34 consisted of an oak canopy with non-native castor bean, thistle, and compass plants dominating the understory.

Work Description: Remove all euphorbia lathyris, castor bean, and thistles; cut off seed heads of castor bean and bag for disposal off site. Thin out large encroaching ornamental African honeysuckle - cut back to approximately 2ft from fenceline, preserving privacy barrier for adjacent house.







Habitat: Work area 35 was dominated by eucalyptus trees along the bluffs.

Work Description: ESA to assess for leaving appropriate raptor perch(s). Remove large standing dead eucalyptus and other adjacent deadwood to the extent feasible (leaving appropriate raptor perches). Remove acacia. Prune adjacent live eucalyptus in work area as needed.





Work Area #: 36

Habitat: Work area 36 consisted of a Monterey cypress tree with eucalyptus growing around it. Biologists surveyed trees along the bluffs to identify suitable raptor perches and identify which trees posed undo risk to the stability of the bluffs that should be removed.

Work Description: Remove young eucalyptus around Monterey cypress.







Habitat: Work area 37 was dominated by non-native eucalyptus trees. Biologists surveyed trees along the bluffs to identify suitable raptor perches, and identify which trees posed undo risk to the stability of the bluffs that should be removed.

Work Description: ESA to assess for raptor perches. Remove all leaning trees at risk of failure.



Work Area #: 38

Habitat: Work area 38 was dominated by non-native eucalyptus trees intermixed with cypress trees along a trail with scattered wild radish in the understory. Biologists surveyed trees along the bluffs to identify suitable raptor perches, and identify which trees posed undo risk to the stability of the bluffs that should be removed.


Work Description: ESA to assess for leaving appropriate raptor perch(s). Remove hazardous deadwood, young eucalyptus, acacia, and all leaning trees at risk of failure (leaving appropriate raptor perches). Prune all live trees to remain as needed.





Habitat: Work area 39 consisted of an acacia tree and castor beans plants surrounded by California sagebrush and other native shrubs. Woodlands border the work area.

Work Description: Remove acacia and stump grind removal sites. Remove all castor bean; cut off seed heads and bag for disposal off site.




Work Area #: 40

Habitat: Work area 40 was dominated by non-native herbaceous vegetation in the understory adjacent to coast live oak woodlands. One eucalyptus is in severe decline in the center of the work area.

Work Description: Remove one unhealthy standing eucalyptus.





Habitat: Work area 41 had an open Monterrey pine habitat with non-native herbaceous annuals in the understory. One pine was deceased. Work Description: Remove dead pine tree.
