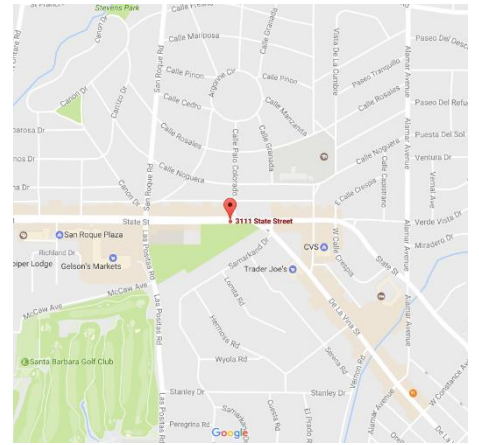


# MACKENZIE CENTER

## About the Venue

The MacKenzie Center is an excellent venue for small parties and functions, located in MacKenzie Park, at the corner of State Street and Las Positas Avenue. The facility has a main meeting room with a fireplace, a spacious patio with a large brick barbecue, full kitchen, and a convenient on-site parking. It is an ideal location for private events such as quinceaneras, baptisms, wedding receptions, graduations, and birthday parties.

## Details

### EIGHT-HOUR WEEKEND PACKAGE RATE

CAPACITY 70

Eight-hour package rate includes tables and chairs (including setup and breakdown), cleaning, presence of event monitor, and security guard. Once a Facility Use / Rental Application is reviewed and approved, a **non-refundable \$300** Reservation Fee is due, which is applied toward the remaining balance owed. The entire balance must be paid in full 30 days prior to the rental date.
